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**GIUSEPPE CAMPAGNOLA AMARONE  
DELLA VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO  
CATERINA ZARDINI RISERVA 2015**

Intense aromas of ripe plums, stewed cherries, cassis, vanilla and mocha. Dried flowers and herbs, too. It's full-bodied with firm, velvety tannins. Plush and rich with concentrated layers of dried-fruit, sweet-spice and toffee notes. Long and luscious. Drink or hold.



**GIUSEPPE CAMPAGNOLA  
AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA  
CLASSICO 2017**

Intense, nutty dried-fruit character on the nose with hints of red licorice and dried flowers. Full-to medium-bodied with silky tannins that are drenched in the fruit flavors. Nicely balanced, forward drive to the long, long finish. Subtler structure for an Amarone, but very skillfully crafted. Drink or hold.



**GIUSEPPE CAMPAGNOLA  
VALPOLICELLA RIPASSO  
CLASSICO SUPERIORE 2019**

Subtle but well-defined aromas of lightly dried black fruit with aromas of toasted coconut and dry stone. Medium body, silky mouth feel and a medium, fruity finish. Nicely done. Drink now.



**PODERE FRONTINO  
MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO  
RISERVA 2017**

Lots of violets color the aromas of ripe black fruit on the nose. Similar balance on the rich, medium-to-full palate with tannins that need a bit of time for better integration. Nice to drink even now, but best after 2022.



**PODERE FRONTINO  
MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO  
2019**

Plums and amarena cherries on the nose with some cedar and sandstone notes. Medium-to full-bodied with lightly firm tannins and a medium, savory finish. Drink or hold.
