



**GIUSEPPE CAMPAGNOLA
MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO PODERE
FRONTINO RISERVA 2015**

There's concentration here aplenty, but what's more encouraging is the vibrancy to the fruit; lavender, bright blackcurrants, citrus and black raspberries all make themselves known. There's a real sense of transparency and energy to the palate, which is full in body and deeply flavorful, yet agile and pure. Grippy, pincer-like tannins pinch out an elegant but long finish. Drink from 2022.

MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO
2018**

A fresh, delightful montepulciano with blueberries, black raspberries, licorice and sesame seeds. Soft and fruity yet bold and firm, this is a vibrant, medium-to full-bodied red to enjoy now.



**ROCOLO DEL LAGO
CORVINA
VERONESE 2017**

This late-harvest red from Veneto shows excellent composure with bright raspberries intermingling with dried citrus. The exuberant cherries are certainly the main feature on the palate, which, medium in body, delivers plenty of crunchy acidity and spicy undertones. Drink now.



**CAMPAGNOLA PINOT GRIGIO
DELLE VENEZIE 2018**

A fresh, floral pinot grigio that also shows green apples and lemons. Light body, fresh acidity and a fruity finish. A little simple, but very drinkable now.



**GIUSEPPE CAMPAGNOLA
AMARONE DELLA
VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO 2016**

This shows real purity of fruit with dense and dark berries, coffee and bitter chocolate. Full and powerful. Drink in 2021 and onwards.
